PROGRAM PURPOSE

“Taking It to the Streets” allows community residents to directly address the needs of their neighborhood without having to wait for over burdened and limited City and County resources to respond. The mission of this program is to encourage citizens to take responsibility for their neighborhoods and affect change for themselves.

Rebuilding Together San Diego has a warehouse full of rakes, shovels, brooms, gloves, trash bags and other materials that we are willing to loan out to support community and youth organizations who want to invest some time to perform debris clean-up, graffiti paint outs, easement planting or street beautification projects to improve their immediate surroundings, or that of others.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM?

Any group of concerned citizens who wish to make a difference in their community is eligible to apply to participate in the Taking It to the Streets Program.

HOW IT WORKS:

There are two ways to participate in Taking It to the Streets:

OPTION 1

Organize a Community Clean Up or Graffiti Paint Out with a group (i.e.: club, church, neighbors). After you have selected a location, date, and determined the number of participants, submit the application to borrow tools and equipment from RTSD. In order to properly plan and accommodate all applicants, please submit your application for equipment 3-6 weeks in advance of your event. Upon receipt of your application, an RTSD staff member will contact you to discuss your exact equipment needs, pick up or delivery dates and return dates. Deposits are due upon check out of the tools by you and are held in our offices. Your same check will be returned to you upon check in of all borrowed equipment.

OPTION 2

RTSD can help you organize your Community Clean Up or Graffiti Paint Out for an administrative fee. RTSD staff will help you choose a suitable location, plan logistics, determine a scope of work, plan materials and equipment needs and coordinate equipment check out. For an additional fee, RTSD staff can man your event and provide registration and site organization services. Please contact RTSD for more information if you are interested in this service.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Deposits collected are to cover any damage to loaned equipment or loss of loaned equipment. The equipment value will be itemized on the Equipment Check-Out Sheet and Program Participants agree that they will be responsible for the listed amount should any tools or equipment be lost or damaged.
- RTSD is a non-profit organization that performs home and neighborhood revitalization projects throughout San Diego County. The proper care and maintenance of our tools and equipment is essential to our program. All Taking It to the Streets Program Participants agree to properly care for and maintain RTSD tools and equipment while in their possession.
- Project Applications should be submitted 3-6 weeks in advance of a scheduled project if possible.
- Organizations wishing to have RTSD staff coordinate their event must apply 6-8 weeks in advance of the project date for groups sizes of 5-50 and 8-12 weeks in advance for groups with 51+ participants.
- Program Participants agree to notify RTSD immediately of any equipment that does not function properly or becomes damaged at their project.
- Delivery service is available for a fee to your organization's address. We will not deliver to storage facilities or locations only accessible by stairs.
- RTSD reserves the right to refuse or terminate any participant at any time at its sole discretion. Except as provided below, if RTSD terminates participation, the participant will be reimbursed on a pro-rated basis for any administrative fees already paid.
- Participation is subject to compliance with Program Guidelines. A violation of any RTSD rules may result in termination of participation with no right to reimbursement of any participation fee paid.
